

The VET4APPS project is a Vocational Education and Training (VET) programme that aims to develop the skills of the mobile app workforce, with a particular focus on business and design skills.



The project will:

Enhance the VET provision for mobile apps entrepreneurs, employees, learners and freelance developers by designing appropriate training courses to address business and design skills needs.

Introduce new training delivery methods, enabling learners to improve and self-assess their business and design skills.

Use and promote European reference tools by linking the designed curriculum with the European Qualifications Framework (EQF) to facilitate mutual recognition and transfer of learning outcomes across the EU

Offer operationally mature open educational resources based on a tested and evaluated training approach and materials.
